

As we wrap up our ELEVENTH YEAR of serving our community, we remain proud of all we've accomplished over the years and in the last 12 months. We are resolute in our commitment to our mission statement of 'Enriching Lives Through Music and Live Performance Education'.

The year 2023 saw us presenting student performances, arts learning programs, and public speaking events throughout our community and region. Our core programming of private music lessons and live student concert performances is stronger than it's ever been! We regularly attract over 150 audience members to our live concerts and have rebuilt our enrollment to exceed pre-pandemic levels.



We have experienced and surpassed the departure of two principal instructors and have successfully built a new and diverse teaching staff that delivers the high level of experience and music education Universal Music Center is founded on.

These very important programs support our marginalized populations and it is our honor to serve these valued community members.


