A note from Founder and Executive Director, MIKE ARTURI

Dear UMC friend and supporter,

As we wrap up our TWELFTH year serving our community, we remain proud of all we've accomplished in years past and in the past twelve months. We are grateful and respectful of the privilege to serve our community with arts, music, and live performance programs. We remain, as we have since our founding in 2012, committed to our mission of 'Enriching lives through music and live performance education'.

2024 was a year of great growth for UMC. We successfully partnered with RiseUp Red Wing Youth Organization to present a day of music and drumming for our local teens and young people. RiseUp students had fun and learned about music and rhythm. We partnered with Red Wing's Hispanic Outreach Organization to present summer programming for Hispanic youth and teens. We met twice a week for four weeks and learned about music, sang, and played hand drums. The program ended with a great student concert for families and friends.



We presented two UMC original summer programs for teens and adults which we plan on repeating in 2025. The Rock Band Factory takes participants through the entire experience of joining a band from audition to stage. The course was led by two young professional musicians and music teachers. Participants chose a set list, rehearsed, created a show, and performed the show live on stage at the historic Sheldon Theatre in Red Wing.

BIONIK Beats offered participants the opportunity to write and record an original song with the highly accomplished producer, composer, and musician; BIONIK (Ice-T, Lizzo, Phil Collins). BIONIK utilized state of the art digital technology to record and produce a multi-layered arrangement of the original song. During the process participants added vocal and instrumental tracks for a first-hand, hands-on experience crafting, performing, recording, and producing a professional final recording. Participants premiered their original composition on stage at the historic Sheldon Theatre in Red Wing.

We continue to serve as music education providers for the Creekstone Montessori School and we will continue to present our Complete Concert Creation course at the Red Wing Juvenile Correctional Facility.

In 2024 we created rapid growth and generated increased support for our Community Outreach programs. As we conclude this year, we are actively providing arts programming for eight local facilities each month. Our programs are providing engaging events for seniors and include drum circles, hand massage therapy, a wide variety of live music options, crafts, storytelling, and poetry. We continue to actively expand our services and facilities.

We remain ever grateful to our community for the opportunities it continues to present. We look forward to continuing to serve our community with arts programming, music, and live performance education.
